## Year 7, 8 & 9 Nurture

Our Nurture Inclusion offer includes a tailored package of support where students are timetabled for the national curriculum within a small, bespoke setting. They will not only get extra support with learning the content, but also will be equipped with the tools to be an independent learner, utilising our own 'Learn2Learn' intervention package which has been developed in house.

Additionally, students will also have access to our extensive therapeutic offer, which includes 1:1 counselling from internal and external providers (Place2Be) and our own DBT skills programmes which upskill students to be resilient, respectful and aspirational individuals.

## 'The Hub @ Witton'

'The Hub' is a research led, holistic, wrap around care package for our students, their families and the wider community in order to interrupt the cycles and patterns that disempower. 'The Hub' includes both an alternative curriculum centre ('The Hub') and a Community support centre (The Family Hub).

'The Hub' is a onsite provision found within a newly refurbished building designed to offer the highest quality curriculum offer to students who need a more personalised and supported approach to their learning.



The core curriculum blends the national curriculum.



The Hub will also offer a variety of therapeutic interventions (embedded in CBT/DBT) and there will be specialised therapeutic spaces, including 'The Sanctuary' where students can practise the therapeutic skills they are taught. Additionally, as part of the central curriculum, we will offer a personalised careers education and enrichment opportunities.

The Family Hub will house a variety of internal and external support for families in Blackburn, including a food bank, uniform swap shop, mental health support and family exercise and cooking classes.
